Watch and pray

The Church of England's Lent theme this year is *Watch* and *Pray*, reminding us of Jesus' words to his disciples in the garden of Gethsemane: 'Could you not keep awake one hour? Keep awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial'. We can take these words with us through Lent. They will help keep us from falling into complacency or apathy, forms of spiritual sleep, when we should be alert to what God may be saying to us in this holy time.

Some people give things up for Lent, like chocolate or alcohol; others take things up, like acts of kindness or generosity. Reading and study may be part of your Lent. Each of us will choose our own spiritual discipline, but prayer should always be at the heart of our routine. Lent is a good opportunity to try praying in a different way from usual, whether by spending time in silence when we usually use words, or by using a different book – in some way varying our practice. Who knows what we may discover? We have a number of special activities this Lent to help, detailed in this newsletter, for example our World Day of Prayer service on Friday 1st March at Hoxne church. This year the service has been put together by the women of Palestine. There will be coffee at 10am, followed by the service at 10.30am.

Lent leads up, of course, to the great celebration of Easter, which falls right at the end of March this year. We'll be celebrating in all of our churches with songs of praise, Easter eggs and our regular but always special thanksgiving to God for the resurrection of Jesus Christ in Holy Communion. I hope you will be able to join us some time over the Easter weekend.


